Through grant and endowment programs, distribution of books and teaching materials, and collaborative volunteer projects, emphasizing foreign exchange of students and faculty, we foster the communion of Ukrainian Americans with the Ukrainian nation and of Roman Catholics in the West with the largest Eastern Catholic Church.

*Endowment funds prepare for the future. Costs in Ukraine are rising dramatically as the economy stabilizes, leaving the Church's educational institutions in greater need. Foreseeing this challenge, a number of individuals and parishes have contributed funds for the UCEF to endow scholarships and professorships in perpetuity. The UCEF Investment Account (including dividends, realized and unrealized gains, and investment fees), added with certain other interests, showed a gain of \$36,275 in 2005.

The most significant news from Ukraine in 2005 was certainly the opening of the new Theological Center for the Ukrainian Catholic Church. Located in the city of Lviv, Ukraine, the Theological Center is now the focal point for theological study for the *entire* Ukrainian Catholic Church, worldwide!

The wonderful news from America is that, thanks to your incredible generosity, the UCEF provided more help in 2005 for the Church in Ukraine *than ever before!* This is *amazing*, considering that Americans are besieged by solicitations from so many other causes (e.g., tsunami and hurricane relief efforts in 2005).

Planned Giving

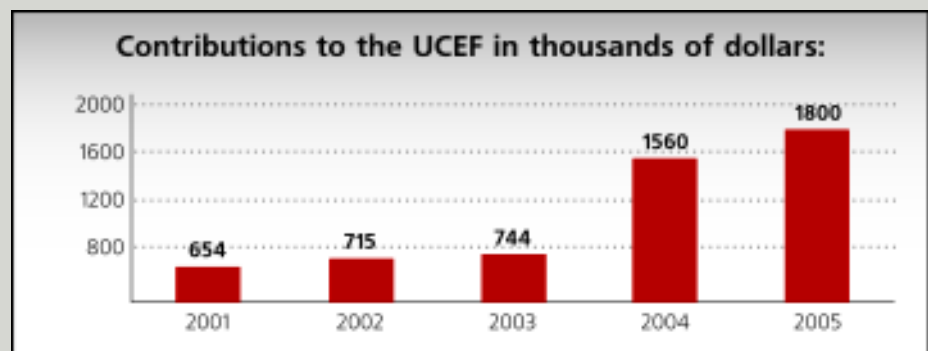
The UCEF is most grateful to all those donors who have included it in their wills and estate plans,

including the late Ms. Helena Panczak. Special attention is here given to a recently-deceased planned giver who was also an alumnus of the pre-war Lviv Theological Academy. The photo shows a fundraising dinner for

Cardinal Josyf Slipyj and the Ukrainian Catholic University (then in exile in Rome) in 1966.

The late Michael Boyko was among the UCEF's most dedicated planned givers. A student of the

pre-war Lviv Theological Academy in the 1930s, Mr. Boyko was buried wearing a new Lviv Theological Academy t-shirt under his suit. His children, Lieda, Olena and Bohdan Boyko, are helping to build up the Michael and Irene Boyko Endowment for Eastern Christian Studies, which was first established by their father.



Highlights of UCEF Activities in 2005

Broadcasting the News

The UCEF entered the airwaves as EWTN Global Catholic Television aired “Light in the East: The Ukrainian Catholic University” in November. An important element of the film was the spring visit to Ukraine of Chicago Cardinal Francis George, which was organized and sponsored by the UCEF.



Sharing a Meal and a Vision

At fundraising dinners and other events throughout the country, Fr. Borys Gudziak, rector of the Ukrainian Catholic University, spoke about the great work of Catholic education in Ukraine. In spring, Fr. Gudziak visited Los Angeles, Florida, Washington, and Baltimore. In the fall, he was enthusiastically greeted in New York, Philadelphia, Chicago, Parma, and the Detroit area, including at a parish school.

Our Self-sacrificing Volunteers

The UCEF continues to be grateful to all donors who generously gave of their time. This includes those who traveled to Ukraine, whether to teach at the Ukrainian Catholic University’s English-language summer school (see photo) or at its Institute of Non-Profit Management, and those who helped organize the North American tours of Rector Fr. Borys Gudziak.



Evangelization

The UCEF’s Bryon Brindel Fund supported 5 summer mission projects, including catechizing and general education at an AIDS hospital in Prokopivsk and youth ministry at a summer camp near the Carpathian Mountains.

Thanks to a grant that the UCEF was awarded from the Raskob Foundation for Catholic Activities, the Ukrainian Catholic University was able to conduct a military chaplaincy program for soldiers in Ukraine’s Armed Forces. Seminarians regularly held religious meetings at 13 military institutions, and 3000 soldiers involved in the program went to confession and received Communion. Also, the first military chapel in western Ukrainian was ceremonially opened on the feast of St. Michael the Archangel (see photo BELOW).

This grant also supported the university’s Mission Society, which sent 16 missionaries to Ukraine’s Donetsk-Kharkiv exarchate, where 236 faithful at 5 parishes took part in summer missions. Also, four missionaries ran fall missions for 50 middle school and high school students. And two seminarians during their Christmas break traveled to northern Russia to help out at mission parishes.



Student Internships

Three students of the Ukrainian Catholic University took part in the Harvard Ukrainian Summer School, and two staff of the Institute of Non-Profit Management interned at Goodwill Industries in Washington, D.C.
